

The 90 Degree Dial -- Make one For Yourself

- 1) Print this page
- 2) Use sharp scissors to cut out the dial very precisely. Do not leave any white space around the edges !
- 3) Laminate it
- 4) Use a needle to make a hole in the dead-center. Off center will lose precision!
- 5) Get a plain manila folder (with straight edges – more room on the sides)
- 6) Again, make a hole in the center of the wide side of the manila folder.
- 7) Now mount the dial on the inside of the folder: Get a thumbtack and run it through this hole – from the outside. Mount the dial on the sharp point of the thumbtack, and then, to protect yourself, put a small piece of rubber (eraser, etc.) on top of this sharp point. Now you are ready to use the dial: Mark the planets around it., etc. More info on this step will be provided later.
